Over the last 4 years they have built 55 classrooms, employed 120 teachers and provided education for 4,500 children in countries such as Columbia, Guatemala, Uganda, Ethiopia and Costa Rica. By the end of 2010 they aim to build 5 more schools and provide education to a further 3100 children.
