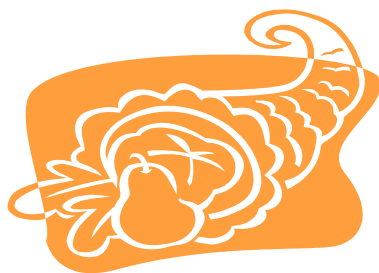
OPEN GARDEN at CHURCH FARM, THORPE

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THORPE PARISH COUNCIL, HELD ON MONDAY 5TH JULY, 2010 AT 7-30PM IN THORPE VILLAGE HALL.

658 DECLARATION OF MEMBERS INTERESTS

Cllr C. Lomas declared a personal interest in item 6(ii) of the agenda (Planning), as he has a close association with Mr Hanson.

659 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

1. Mr Peter Foley, D.D.D.C. – Review of Public Conveniences
(possible closure of public toilets in Thorpe village)

Mr Foley opened his report by stating that due to financial cuts, the decision taken, after 12-18mths survey is not about closing, but giving better quality toilets in the Derbyshire area. There are options available, one is to perhaps have seasonal opening but closed at night, or, local ownership.

In the latter the Council would “gift” the car park & toilets to the Parish Council, who would then take over the running & maintenance. An “honesty box” in the car park could be one idea to cover some of the costs.

He then gave estimated annual expenses to be considered:-

Cleaning - £3000; Repairs - £500; Water - £880; Electricity - £600;

Rates - £1500

Insurance including Public Liability – no costs available.

He stressed that the immediate repairs needed would cost approx £3300, which the Council would give for the Parish Council to use at their discretion. However, future repairs could run up to £6000.

If the Parish Council decided not to take over the running of the conveniences, then by the end of September a decision will have to be made on whether to have seasonal opening, or close them down.

He agreed to send a list of up to date costs & repairs needed.

The Parish Council queried “Risk Management” and informed Mr Foley they would have to get advice on this.

Agreed – To contact Cllr S. Spencer, for the views of the District Council, & invite him to a meeting to discuss this further; also, to contact DALC for the general consensus on this problem.

Cllr A. Wager thanked Mr Foley for his attendance & report.

Mr Foley left the meeting.

2. Mrs B. Wager stated that according to reports, 5 million visitors enter the Peak Park/Derbyshire Dales a year, and D.D.D.C., Peak Park & The National Trust all encourage tourism to this area, so why close the much needed Public Conveniences.

Agreed – To write to The National Trust & Peak Park for their comments.
