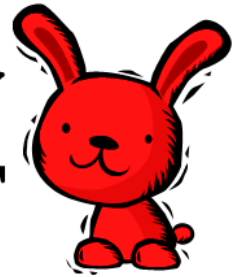


OPERATION RED RABBIT

Important Information – Parwich Primary Students

Transport arrangements / drop off and collection

Children will need to be in school by 8.30am as we are walking to Tissington. Children will require good, strong walking shoes and clothes suitable for being outdoors all day.

Collection will be back at school for approximately 3.30pm.

Refreshments / lunch

During the day there will be one morning, one afternoon and a lunch break. Please provide your child with a packed lunch, drinks and snacks for the two breaks in a named bag.

Clothing

For identification purposes we ask that all children wear their school uniform t-shirts and sweatshirt. We hope for a sunny day, so children will need sun hats and cream, although we would appreciate your help; we encourage parents to use the once daily protection before sending your child to school, as applying cream to 50 children would be rather exhaustive and time consuming.

Please also provide a coat to cope with light showers.

Wet Weather

In the event of very wet weather we will cancel the fun day at Tissington and instead bring some of the activities to the children at their schools. If this is the case we will notify you in writing through the school on Tuesday 12th July.
