School Lunch Money

Our school policy inline with Derbyshire County Council is that school meals should be paid for in advance. We do appreciate that as we ask for dinner money payments to be made on a **Monday only**, there may be occasions when your account is in arrears – however this should never exceed 5 meals. If you accumulate an amount that exceeds Derbyshire County Council's limit then a debt referral is made to their Debt Collection Dept who will then pursue payment. We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child's dinner money account is up to date before the end of term – the last day for payments is Monday 12th December. We cannot accept payments after this date as all money needs to be banked before the end of term.
