Standard Terms of Reference for the meeting given from the Agenda by Sgt Edwards.

Minutes of the previous meeting discussed.

SE suggested site meeting for area of continual flooding on A515 near to Ashbourne Heights. Form 421 to be despatched to Traffic Management Unit. KC

SE discussed thefts of catalytic converters, usually evening times. Swadlingcote had been hit quite badly.

An event at Carsington Water for marking and advice for 4x4 vehicle owners is to take place on Sunday 23 September. Community Safety have organised this event and Police will be in attendance. Products will be on sale. Police website will give more details.

SE There were no more copper piping thefts, this could possibly be due to arrests made in the West Midlands. The campaign to check scrap dealers premises was to continue by Police.

SE Children in Belper being approached – there were no further incidents reported, one person had been spoken to. No immediate concerns.

SE Scrap thefts at Carsington – noise was heard by a resident and a yellow van was followed, this resulted in three males being arrested in Derby. A stolen motorbike was found at the address as a result of the arrests. Awareness of people asking for scrap.

SE Domestic oil thefts. An incident was reported at Darley Dale where a blue van was seen.

SE Speeding issues. The Mobile Police Station (MPS) is available for the villages when available (based at Ashbourne for the next week). The MPS has a light on the rear that shows the speed restriction. This has been successful in several of the villages with speeding issues.

Speeding on the A515 has been addressed. Concerns were around the Sandybrook to Ashbourne stretch. Speed rosettes have now been placed. A positive result by a simple solution after a site survey.

SE Changes to the Safer Neighbourhood Policing Team (SNPT) areas are now in place.

SE Two E-Forum messages from residents regarding the same speeding issues for the SNPT have been addressed. Motorbikes at Carsington. Op Focus surveys areas for fatalities, where road traffic collisions (RTC) occur and general road traffic statistics. Carsington area will not have a survey until a fatality occurs unfortunately. KC to contact Traffic Management Unit. CREST will not attend unless statistics deem it necessary. MPS not suitable for the road at Carsington. Roads Policing are aware and will be contacted KC.

AB Concerns expressed regarding overtaking and speeding on the stretch of the A515 approaching the Bluebell Inn and Tissington Village gates. KC will contact Traffic Management Unit.

DS expressed concern regarding signage at the Bentley Brook Hotel corner. KC task.

BW was concerned that the Mountain Rescue Team vehicles were speeding through Thorpe. KC will contact.

AB suggested a mapping/grid reference system for Ambulance (EMAS) would be useful as recently this was an issue in the village of Tissington when a person could not be found easily at a property. KC to investigate at Police HQ regarding a simple map for the residents.

BW asked for assistance in advising a resident of Thorpe to cut back hedge. KC tasked.

JC informed the meeting of a new security system at Bradbourne Church. It was installed by a company that may be found on the internet. Several churches have used the company including Mayfield Church, Bonsall Church.

The meeting was closed.
