



School attendance: penalty notices

Derbyshire County Council is committed to providing all children with the best start in life. Good school attendance is a key factor in ensuring that children can make the most of their education.

The majority of parents and carers in Derbyshire ensure that their children attend school regularly. Unfortunately for a small but significant minority that is not the case. As a result, the local authority may decide to begin the process of issuing a legal penalty notice for unauthorised absence from school.

The legal basis for penalty notices

The law says that parents and carers whose children of compulsory school age are absent from school without good reason are committing an offence, and those parents may be prosecuted in the Magistrate's Court. Section 23 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Act 2003 introduced additional powers under Section 444 of the Education Act 1996 authorising local authorities to issue penalty notices in cases of unauthorised absence from school.
