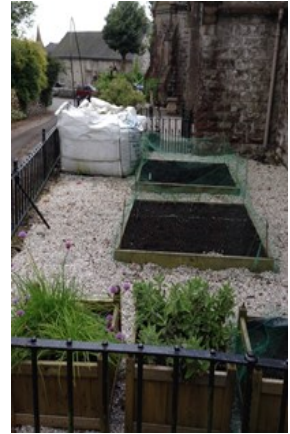

Eco Committee - School Garden

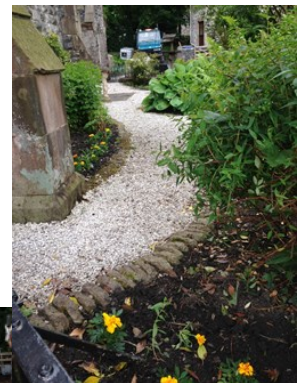
